## **ABOUT THE COURSE:**

HeartCode<sup>™</sup> BLS is an interactive, self-directed training course that meets all requirements of the American Heart Association BLS Course. HeartCode BLS includes all exams required for the successful completion of the BLS curriculum.

HeartCode BLS includes: BLS lessons, two interactive patient scenarios, one adult and one infant case and the full text of the AHA BLS for Healthcare Providers Manual.

HeartCode BLS offers an alternative to traditional classroom courses.

- HeartCode allows you to learn at your own pace, on your own schedule.
- HeartCode includes instant feedback and debriefing.

HeartCode BLS codes can be requested through your unit leaders and currently offered for re-certifications only.

Initial BLS HeartCode can be obtained by the employee through the <u>American Heart</u> <u>Association website</u> for a fee. The return demonstration check off can be completed at UMCNO without a charge for employees.

## **BLS re-certification in two steps:**

- At any location with Internet access and on your own schedule, successfully complete the Part 1 cognitive portion, including patient scenarios and multiple choice exam.
- 2. At the UMC, any scheduled time during business hours, successfully complete the Part 2 skills test administered by an American Heart Association certified Instructor.

Receive your new AHA BLS Provider card upon successful completion of Part 2.

BLS Manuals are available for review and checkout through the Clinical/Nursing Education Department. These are loaner manuals and need to be returned during the return demonstration check off.
